Drom National School Traffic Calming, Drom, Co Tipperary.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transportation Regulation Act 2009, Tipperary County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to deliver Drom National School Traffic Calming Scheme.

The proposed development includes the following key components:

- **Raised Speed Table Installation:** Located on L-3213-13 outside Drom National School, installation of two number raised speed tables with associated signage and drainage, designed to reduce traffic speeds in the area, promoting safer driving conditions & additional student safety.
- **Pedestrian Zebra Crossing (Type B):** Integrated into the raised speed table, the zebra crossing will provide designated safe crossing point for students & pedestrians.
